Certificate 3 Guarantee

Payment plans are available – either pay by the unit or by fortnightly instalments. Payment in full is required before completion of the course.

Refunds

Once training has commenced, refunds will be given on a pro-rata basis, in accordance with the agreed training plan. For those units where training has commenced, no fees will be refunded. If fees have been paid in advance and no training has commenced, nor have resources been issued, then fees for those units will be refunded in total. If paying per unit, refunds will only be issued if 7 days notice has been given before commencement of training, or before issuance of resources.

Cancellation of Training

You are not required to pay back any of the government subsidy paid to the training provider for training funded under the Certificate 3 Guarantee Program or the Higher Level Skills Program.
